Members of the sound bath are invited to lay on custom-made, wool-felted twin size mats intentionally designed & crafted by **Helen Banner** herself. The periwinkle wool and gossamer like, iridescent sheet resembles that of Titania's fairy bed in Shakespeare's A Midsummer Night's Dream; The perfect fairy bed made for soft landing after long days spent sashaying down concrete-jungled streets. Water & eye masks were offered to deepen the experience.

**Andrea Goodman**, Sound Healer & Vocalist, attends energetically to guests, offering her hands to soothe & move the orchestral sounds through each member's energetic field in the tradition & practice of Reiki energy work.

Participants are invited to make sounds & join with the chorus of it all, echoing the eons of classical chants & original sonic explorations in a connected and reflective atmosphere.
